- ☺ Magazines/newspapers (like Time For Kids & Scholastic News)
- ☺ File folders
- ☺ Worksheets

**DO NOT recycle:**

- ☹ Construction paper
- ☹ Napkins, paper towels
- ☹ Paper with glue, paint, or crayon on it
- ☹ Kleenex tissues
- ☹ School books, binders
- ☹ Pocket folders
- ☹ Primary handwriting paper
